

Read the instructions and keep them safe. If you pass the appliance on, pass on the instructions too. Remove all packaging, but keep it till you know the appliance works.

important safeguards

Follow basic safety precautions, including:

- 1 This appliance must only be used by or under the supervision of a responsible adult. Use and store the appliance out of reach of children.
- 2 Don't put the kettle, stand, cable, or plug in any liquid; don't use the kettle in a bathroom, near water, or outdoors.
- 3 Don't touch hot surfaces. Use the handle and lid button.
- 4 Don't use the kettle without the filter in place it may spit boiling water
- 5 Don't open the lid while the water is heating.
- 6 Take care when pouring pour slowly, and don't over-tilt the kettle.
- 7 The scald hazard lasts long after boiling. Keep the kettle, stand, and cable away from the edges of worktops and out of reach of children.
- 8 Route the cable so it doesn't overhang, and can't be tripped over or caught.
- 9 Wind excess cable beneath the stand.
- 10 Unplug the stand when not in use, before moving and before cleaning. Let the kettle cool down before cleaning and storing away.
- 11 Check the lid is fully closed before switching the kettle on, otherwise it may not switch off.
- 12 Check the kettle is properly located on the stand before switching on.
- 13 Don't switch on unless the kettle contains at least 2 cups of water.

- 14 Don't fill past max, or it may spit boiling water.
- 15 Remove the kettle from its stand before filling or pouring.
- 16 Keep the kettle, stand, cable, and plug away from sources of heat.
- 17 Don't use the kettle for any purpose other than heating water.
- 18 This appliance must not be operated by an external timer or remote control system.
- 19 Use the kettle only with the stand supplied (and vice versa).
- 20 The appliance must only be connected to an earthed power socket.
- 21 Don't use the appliance if it's damaged or malfunctions.
- 22 If the cable is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent, or someone similarly qualified, in order to avoid hazard.

household use only

before using for the first time

Fill to max, boil, discard the water, then rinse. Do this three times, to remove manufacturing dust, etc.

positioning

- 1 Put the stand on a stable, level surface. Route the cable so it doesn't overhang, and can't be caught or tripped over.
- 2 Wind excess cable beneath the stand

filling

caution keep clear, steam may escape from the lid.

- 3 Switch the kettle off move the switch to O.
- 4 Remove the kettle from the stand.
- 5 Press the lid release button to open the lid.
- 6 Fill with at least 2 cups of water, but not above max (inside the kettle).
- 7 If you overfill, the kettle may spit boiling water.
- 8 To close the lid, press the button on the centre of the lid, till you hear it click.
- 9 Be careful, the button may be hot.
- 10 Check the lid is closed, or the kettle won't switch off when it boils.

switching on

- 11 Check the switch is off (move it to ()).
- 12 Plug the stand into the wall socket.
- 13 Put the kettle on the stand take care not to spill.
- 14 Move the switch to |.
- 15 The light will come on, and the kettle will heat up.

switching off

- 16 When the water boils the kettle will switch off, the switch will return to \bigcirc and the light will go out.
- 17 To switch off manually, move the switch to O.

general

- 18 Remove the kettle from the stand before pouring.
- 19 To avoid the risk of splashing, pour slowly and don't over-tilt the kettle.
- 20 Don't tilt the kettle backwards, water might get on to the control area. If this happens, let the kettle dry before use sit it somewhere warm for 12 hours.
- 21 When you lift the kettle, you may see moisture on the stand. Don't worry it's the steam used to switch off automatically, which then condenses and escapes via vents under the kettle.
- 22 You may see some discolouration on the floor of the kettle. Again, don't worry it's due to the bonding of the element to the kettle floor.

using with insufficient water

- 23 This will shorten the life of the element. A boil-dry cut-out will switch the kettle off.
- 24 You must then remove the kettle from its stand to reset the cut-out.
- 25 Sit the kettle on the work surface till it's cold.
- 26 Don't fill it the kettle till it's cold, or it may spit.

care and maintenance

- 27 Switch the kettle off (()), unplug the stand from the wall socket, and let the kettle cool down fully before cleaning.
- 28 Wipe the kettle, inside and out, with a damp cloth. You may use a little household detergent, but if you do, rinse well to avoid tainting the water.
- 29 Keep all connectors and sockets dry.
- 30 Don't put the kettle or stand in any liquid.
- 31 Don't use harsh or abrasive cleaning agents or solvents.

water filter

32 Scale particles suspended in the water may give it a cloudy or greasy appearance. The filter will prevent these particles going into your drink. If you see deposits on the filter, clean it, otherwise the performance of your kettle will drop, your drinks may contain scale, and the water inside the kettle may look cloudy.

cleaning the filter

- 33 Check your hands are free from soap, or anything which might leave a taint.
- 34 Switch the kettle off, and let it cool.
- 35 Open the lid.
- 36 Use the tab on the filter to pull the filter out of the guides, then lift it out of the kettle.
- 37 Rinse the filter under a running tap while brushing with a soft brush.
- 38 Rinse the kettle, in case scale particles have fallen inside.
- 39 Push the top of the filter between the guides, stop when you can't push it any further.
- 40 Give the filter a gentle shake to check it's fitted correctly.
- 41 Close the lid.

caution don't use the kettle without the filter in place – it may spit boiling water

descale regularly

- 42 Limescale may be white, coloured, even rusty-looking.
- 43 It may cause overheating, and reduce the working life of the element. It may also make the safety cutout operate prematurely, switching the kettle off before the water boils.
- 44 As the element is mounted beneath the kettle, scale can build up only on the walls and floor of the kettle, where it can be seen and dealt with.
- 45 If you see scale forming, wipe it off.
- 46 Descale regularly, (at least monthly) to keep your kettle in good working order.
- 47 Use a descaler suitable for use in plastic products (most products have plastic parts). Follow the instructions on the descaler, rinse several times, then fill, boil and discard the water, to ensure no residues are left.
- ☼ Products returned under guarantee with faults due to scale will be subject to a repair charge.

wheelie bin symbol




CHANGING THE PLUG
